

Small quake hits central Oklahoma

A small earthquake struck parts of Oklahoma and Cleveland counties Monday afternoon, officials said.

Jim Lawson, Chief Physicist of the Oklahoma Geological Survey, said early reports indicate the quake registered at least 2.5 on the Richter scale. The tremor, which happened about 5:30 p.m., was felt from Norman up to 5 miles north of the Will Rogers World Airport.

There were no reports of any damage or injuries.
